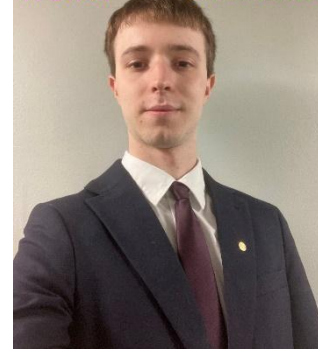
What revisions would you like to make to the SASSE budget (1 sentence what, 1 sentence why)?

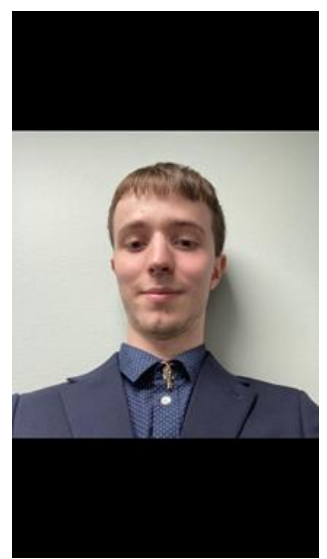

Therefore, I would like to help out setting strategies and long-term operational practices making sure the association can handle these issues/big events so that everyone can focus more on work that have more day-to-day impact for you as a SASSE member.
3. Lastly I would like to see a council that is open for opinions, discussions and arguments - but at the same time structured, efficient and not too involved in operational details. Putting high standards on each other, but also trusting each other. I think we will come a long way by that.
